## Is she getting Botox?

Even Regis Philbin thinks Kelly has used Botox. "You can't frown," he told his 33-year-old co-host on *Live with Regis & Kelly* on May 5. "It's not Botox!" Kelly protested. "I use Dr. Brandt's Crease Release cream. You put it on like moisturizer — no injections. It's like a face-lift in a jar." But our experts side with Regis. "She's definitely had Botox done," suggests LA cosmetic surgeon Dr. Simon Ourian. "I'm certain she's had it around her eyebrows and eyes." Dr. Paul Jarrod Frank, a dermatologist, agrees: "She can't move her upper face" — another sign, he thinks, that Kelly's had the injection treatments. Since younger actresses like Jennifer Garner are always being heralded as "the next Julia Roberts," 36-year-old Julia has added pressure not to become the *old* Julia Roberts. Dr. Frank believes the superstar has had some lip service on her Mona Lisa Smile. "Her lips were always full, but they were asymmetrical and quirky," he notes, "but now they look symmetrical, and that's a giveaway that she may have had collagen implants." Although Julia has never addressed the question of having cosmetic surgery, she does say, "Whether it's plastic surgery or running four miles when you get out of bed in the morning... if something makes you happy you should do whatever it is."

## ▶ JOHNNY DEPP Is it just good genes?

He was a hard-living Hollywood parry boy who still smokes and drinks. So how does 40-year-old Johnny look so young? "He has no wrinkles in his smile lines he gets either collagen, Restylane or Radiance injected," suggests Dr. David Goldberg, a cosmetic dermatologist. But the actor's hairstylist, Laurent D., thinks Johnny's secret is genetic. "I don't think he's had anything done," he says. ## Instant face-lifts — without surgery

These tricks give the illusion of a face-lift — without the risks (or the pain!) of surgery



**UP 'DO**  
Stylist Oribe pulled Jennifer Lopez's hair

tightly to her crown, "making the face look younger" by tightening the skin. "The braids made it look very youthful and fun as well," he says.



**SIDE-SWEPT BANGS**

A long, swept-over fringe, here on Beyoncé, opens up the forehead and keeps the face from looking "like Minnie Mouse!" says stylist Yuki Sharoni. It creates a slimmer, sleeker look and draws the eye upwards.



**LONG EARRINGS**  
Chandelier earrings —

like Debra Messing's — that drop just below the jaw can slim and trim the features. As stylist George Blodwell notes, "They elongate the face." Big, round earrings only make an oval face appear even rounder.

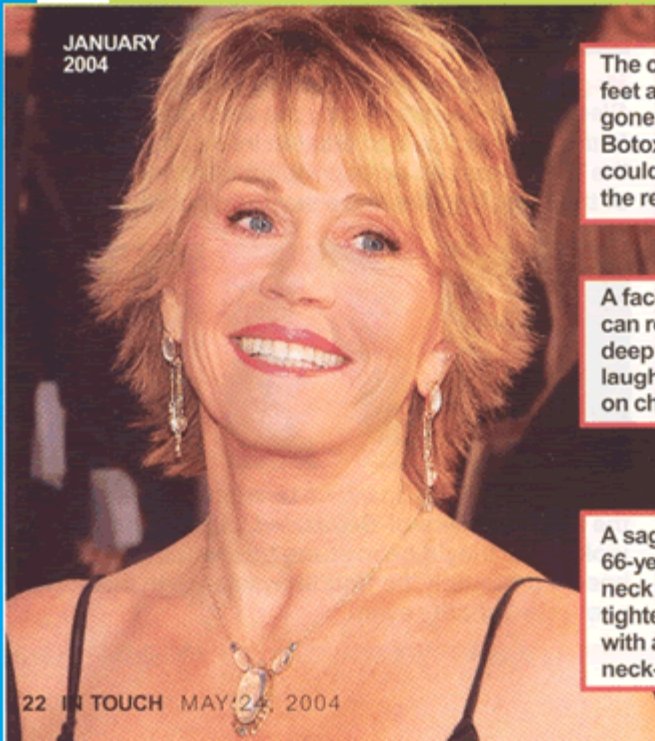
Jane Fonda's new face

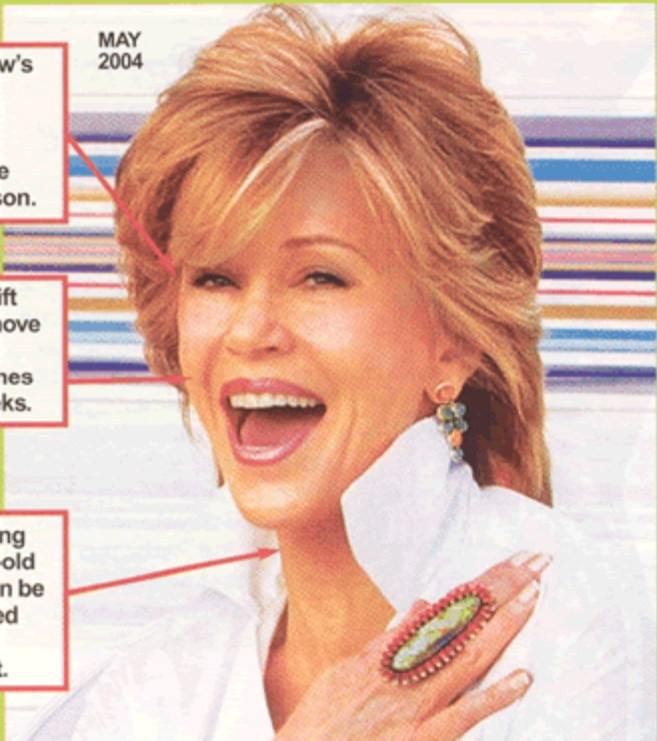
